

Olympus Young Investigator Award

Objective: The executive board of the **Spanish Society of Neuroscience (SENC)** and **Olympus Iberia** are pleased to announce the **Olympus Young Investigator Award**. Olympus Iberia identifies and supports some of the best young researchers in Neuroscience. The Olympus Young Investigator Award recognizes the efforts of young neuroscientists and encourages them to continue their future career in Spain. This award aims to promote her/his research lines and promising scientific career, as well as to distinguish her/his excellent scientific track records after the PhD (2-12 years after PhD).

Award: The prize includes an accreditation and **3,000 Euros** donation.

Eligibility:

1. Applicant must be an active SENC member when sending the submission form.
2. Applicant limiting age: 35 years at the date of deadline.
3. To be working in a Spanish lab for the last year (continuously).
4. Applicant must participate with a communication at the SENC Biennial Meeting.
5. The selected applicant will be presented at the SENC Meeting, where she/he will present a plenary talk (30 min), included for that purpose in the official program of the meeting.
6. The selected applicant will be invited to join the SENC Young Investigators Committee for the next two years.

Procedure:

Submission: the proposals will be submitted through the Private Members Area of the SENC website (<https://www.senc.es/private-area/>), including the following information:

- Candidate's CV.
- Recommendation letters from 2 ordinary SENC members.

Deadlines: **May 31st** of uneven years.

The Olympus Young Investigator Award will be evaluated by SENC Young Investigators Committee. The SENC executive board will announce the prize by June 30th of uneven years.
