#### Registration

Attendance is limited to 80 participants. Presentations: Authors willing to present their communications should submit an abstract (example below) and indicate their preference for oral or poster presentation. Oral presentations will be selected on the basis of quality and originality. Abstracts must be sent to the following address: secretaria.senc@kenes.com

Deadline for abstract submission is April 10th. Abstracts will be accepted only if registration fees of the presenting author have been received. Authors will receive a confirmation via e-mail once registration has been completed.

Authors selected for oral presentations must bring their PowerPoint presentations in portable USB devices. Poster presentations will be allocated to three different sessions (one per day) and will be on display for the entire day. Authors should be at their posters between 19:00 and 20:30 h on the corresponding day. Poster size must be 90 cm x 120 cm portrait.

#### **Travel fellowships**

An important task of SENC is helping young scientists to attend Neuroscience meetings. As for SENC Congresses and FENS Forums, SENC offers travel fellowships to PhD students and recent postdocs (less than two yr after PhD) to partly cover travel and accommodation expenses. Fifteen fellowships of 200 € (SENC/FENS members) and 10 of 100 € (non-members) will be awarded by should IBRO and SENC. Applicants send an email to secretaria.senc@kenes.com, detailing their motives for attending the CV conference . #### **Abstract form**


