

Call for SENC-Day + IBRO Meeting 2023 TRAVEL AWARDS

Objective: The Spanish Society for Neuroscience opens a call for travel award applications to attend the SENC-Day + IBRO Meeting 2023, Granada, Spain, September 8-13 (https://ibro2023.org/):

Funding. 50 awards, 35 for PhD students and 15 for early career postdoctoral researchers (350€).

Eligibility criteria:

- \checkmark To be active SENC member at the time of the application.
- √ To submit an abstract as first presenting author
- \checkmark To be ≤ 35 years old

Deadline: The call opens March 20th 2023 and closes April 21st 2023.

How to apply:

Applicants need to access the "Private area" \rightarrow "Becas Asistencia SENC-IBRO" at the SENC website (https://www.senc.es/en/senc-grants/) to fill in and upload the following information:

- ✓ A copy of the abstract to be presented at the SENC-IBRO Meeting.
- √ A short (300 words) motivation letter, stating how/why the applicant would benefit from the award. The applicant should disclose applications to additional funds from other sources for the same purpose.
- \checkmark For PhD students, a letter from the PhD Supervisor or Department Head certifying that the applicant is pursuing his/her PhD.
- \checkmark For postdocs, state in the web form the date of PhD dissertation.
- ✓ For PhD students, state in the web form the number of years in the PhD program.

Evaluation criteria:

- 1. Novelty and relevance of the study presented in the abstract (scientific excellence). Clear priority will be given to unpublished studies (at the time of abstract submission) on timely topics that propose innovative ideas.
- 2. Relevance of the reasons for the application.
- 3. Preference will be given to applicants who have never received SENC support before.

Grants will be announced by May 12th, 2023.

- √ Certificate of attendance.
- \checkmark A statement indicating that he/she has NOT received any other related award.
- √ The bank account number.
