


# **Excellent Student Rita Levi-Montalcini Award**

#### Aim

The Young Investigators and Education Committee (CJIF) of SENC organizes this event to give visibility to the Society's young researchers pursuing their PhD and to provide them with an opportunity to showcase their best science.

## Information

The Young Investigators and Education Committee(CJIF) will pre-select five PhD students applying for the award. The selected students will deliver a 15-minute presentation during the session, after which the Committee will vote for the best presentation. The winner will receive the Rita Levi-Montalcini Award for the best PhD student talk, valued at €600, at the end of the session. All participants will receive a diploma.
