

Tatiana Foundation Young Investigator Award

The executive board of the Spanish Society of Neuroscience (SENC) is pleased to announce the Tatiana Foundation Young Investigator Award. This Award is intended to identify and support the future leaders of Spanish research in Neuroscience. By distinguishing excellent scientific track records after obtaining PhD (up to 8 years after PhD), the award expects to encourage young neuroscientists to continue their promising scientific career in Spain.

Award: The award winner will

- 1. receive an invitation to deliver a Plenary Lecture at the 20th SENC Meeting, Las Palmas de Gran Canaria, Spain, Sept 3-5, 2025 (https://congresosenc.es/)
- 2. receive a diploma
- 3. receive a 3000 € award
- 4. be invited to join the SENC Young Investigator Committee for the next two years.

Eligibility: Applicants must

- 1. be active SENC members when applying.
- 2. have obtained their PhD \leq 8 years from the deadline of the application (one year extension for each parental or severe health leave $- \ge 3$ months- would apply).
- 3. have continuously worked in a Spanish Institution at least during the last year.
- present a communication at the SENC Biennial Meeting.

Submission: The proposals will be submitted to the Technical SENC Secretary (secretaria.tecnica@senc.es) including the following information:

- 1. Candidate's CV.
- 2. Recommendation letters from 2 ordinary SENC members.

Selection procedure: The SENC executive board, together with one member of the Scientific Council for Neuroscience of the Tatiana Foundation, will evaluate the candidatures and announce the Award by June30th, 2025.

Deadline: The call opens April 10th 2025 and closes June 10th 2025.
